Nagaoka University of Technology holds this program every summer and it is open for the overseas students who are in their third year of university undergraduate programs. The purpose of this program is to introduce NUT to the students in all over the world by offering the opportunity to participate in research at the laboratories and experience life in Japan.

This year, the program was conducted from August 19 to August 30, and we welcomed 20 students from 14 universities and 9 different countries as follows:

- Mechanical Engineering laboratories: 2 students (Malaysia: 2)
- Electrical, Electronics and Information Engineering laboratories: 2 students (Malaysia: 1, Korea 1)
- Civil and Environmental Engineering laboratory: 4 students (Indonesia: 3, Malaysia: 1)
- Bioengineering laboratory: 3 students (Indonesia: 1, Taiwan: 1, Malaysia: 1)
- Science of Technology Innovation laboratories: 8 (Uzbekistan: 1, Mongol: 1, Indonesia: 2, India: 2, Thailand: 1, Spain: 1)

During the program, participants worked together with NUT students to conduct research in laboratories, and they had company visit to Union Tool Co. Nagaoka Factory and Okutadami Dam to explore Japanese industrial innovation. They also participated in the Tea Ceremony at Shoraikaku on the last day of the program, and they all enjoyed to learn more about traditional Japanese culture.
