## **Electronic Money and ATM (Automated Teller Machine) on Campus**

### **1. Electronic Money**

At campus cafeterias and shop, the students may pay by cash or electronic money, such as "Edy (prepaid)", "QUICPay (deferred payment)", "Suica", "nanaco", "iD".

Since many students use campus cafeterias or shop during lunch time, it may take long time to pay at cashier of cafeterias or shop. If the students use electronic money for payment, you may use lunch time effectively. **At campus cafeterias or shop, if the students make a payment of books (textbooks) or magazines using electronic money, you will receive 5% discount.** Also, the students may use prepaid card for purchasing books as well as credit card to purchase stationery, food and etc.

- In order to use electronic money, you need to obtain IC card with electronic money.
- For Edy and QUICPay, please read page 2.

### **\*Precautions to use electronic money**

Campus cafeterias, shop and the university are not responsible for damage of embedded IC card (IC card), lost and stolen card. In case of Edy, campus cafeterias, shop and the university do not guarantee the amount of money lost. In case of QUICPay, the student is responsible for lost and late payment and contact with each credit company.

Also, the student is not able to obtain the points of award program. Please understand above and use electronic money.

## Edy and QUICPay

### 1. Edy (prepaid)

- (1) To use Edy, you need to charge first and the amount used will be withdrawn from charged amount. To use Edy, please purchase Edy card or set up wallet application on your mobile phone (you need to download the application).
- (2) There are credit machines for Edy at campus cafeterias and shop.
- (3) You may use Edy at the member stores of Edy in Japan. You may use Edy at convenience stores (Seven-Eleven, Lawson and Family Mart) near the university.
- (4) You are not able to obtain the points of award program if you use Edy at campus cafeterias or shop.

### 2. QUICPay (deferred payment)

[In case of using credit card] Please go to the following URL for the details (Japanese only).

- (1) To use QUICPay, you need to apply for credit card with the QUICPay service. You may use QUICPay card by proceeding one of (a) to (c) below.
  - (a) Obtain a credit card and activate QUICPay service.
  - (b) Obtain a credit card and a separate QUICPay card. Use a separate QUICPay card as a family card.
  - (c) Obtain a credit card and set up wallet application on your mobile phone as a QUICPay family card. (You need to download the application.)Above mentioned QUICPay service ((a) to (c)) differs depending on the credit card company. Therefore, please contact credit card company for the details.
- (2) Settlement amount by using QUICPay at the campus cafeterias or shop is the same as credit card payment.
- (3) You may use QUICPay at the member stores of QUICPay in Japan.
- (4) You are not able to obtain the points of award program if you use QUICPay at campus cafeterias or shop.
- (5) You are responsible for contacting credit card company for lost or stolen card.
