Precautions for Returning Home During the Long Vacation and Matters After the Vacation (Notification)

All students have been notified of the university's behavioral guidelines for COVID-19 as of April 8, 2021; any students planning to return home or travel during the long May vacation are strongly requested to behave with care so as to prevent infection, based on the guidelines. In addition, classes after the long vacation will be held as follows; please take especial care.

1. During the holiday in May, many students will return to their homes outside the prefecture and/or be more likely to meet with friends visiting Niigata from other prefectures, leading to concerns about the spread of COVID-19 infection. Therefore, students are requested to take particular care to avoid infection. As well, as at the beginning of the school year, **all students** should return to Nagaoka by May 5, the last day of the vacation, **and should not enter the university for the following two weeks (May 6 to May 19).**

Students may enter the university in the following situations.

- (1) When lab work must be continued, with permission obtained from the instructor
 - (2) When using amenities such as the student cafeteria or shop for a short period of time
2. Outside the period mentioned in 1. above, students traveling to other prefectures for job searches, etc., while not asked to refrain from entering the university, are to behave carefully with special attention to preventing infection while traveling and upon their return to Nagaoka. Any students with a fever or other signs of ill health are to contact the Niigata Prefecture COVID-19 Advice Centers below, follow their instructions, and notify their instructors and the contact points below.
