

## **Support for Students with Disabilities and Reasonable Accommodations**

### **○ Support for Students with Disabilities at NUT**

In accordance with the *Act for Eliminating Discrimination Against Persons with Disabilities*, NUT is committed to providing academic support for students with physical, mental, or developmental disabilities, as well as other functional impairments. To ensure that students with disabilities have equal access to education and campus life, the university provides reasonable accommodations based on each student's individual request and determined through collaborative discussion.

### **○ Reasonable Accommodations**

< Conditions for Determining Reasonable Accommodations >

- The student has formally requested reasonable accommodations.
- The implementation of accommodations must not impose an undue burden on the university.
- Accommodations apply to all aspects of education, research, and other related activities at the university.
- The changes and adjustments are necessary and appropriate to ensure the provision of opportunities to receive an education equivalent to that of other students.
- The accommodations do not fundamentally alter the purpose, content, or evaluation of education and research.
- The request must be supported by official documentation (e.g., medical certificates or doctor's opinion letters, specialist's opinion letters, and records of previous support).
- The accommodations must not infringe upon the rights or interests of the student with disabilities or any third party.
- If a requested accommodation would result in an unfair advantage over other students or place an undue burden on the university, we will inform the student of the situation. In such cases, we will consult with the student to discuss why a specific accommodation cannot be provided and work together to identify viable alternative solutions.
