### **Notice for wearing masks**

Due to the announcement of the policy for wearing masks by the government, the university has decided to set the policy for wearing masks especially during the lectures to avoid high risk of heatstroke in summer.

#### **[Lectures and Seminars]**

1. In principle, the students should wear masks during lectures and seminars. (Non-woven masks are recommended.)
2. The students should use air-conditioning appropriately to avoid exceeding room temperature over 28°C.
3. Rooms should be well-ventilated. (Open the windows from two directions continuously, or continuous operation of heat-exchange equipped ventilating fan.)
4. It is not necessary to wear masks in case that the students keep enough distance (about 2m) among them or make conversation rarely during conducting experiment, practice or exercise outside.

\*Please follow the infection prevention measures to avoid heatstroke by using non-woven masks for summer, or drinking water properly.

\*In case of difficulty of wearing masks due to hypersensitivity, skin or respiratory disease (including the case that the health condition becomes worse by wearing masks):

- 1) Academic staff are permitted to conduct lectures without masks. However, he/she should explain the reason to the students in advance, keep distance from students over 2m, as well as using plexiglass dividers.
- 2) Students are permitted to take lectures without masks. However, he/she should consult with lecturers in advance and obtain permission.
