

7. HANDLING EMERGENCIES

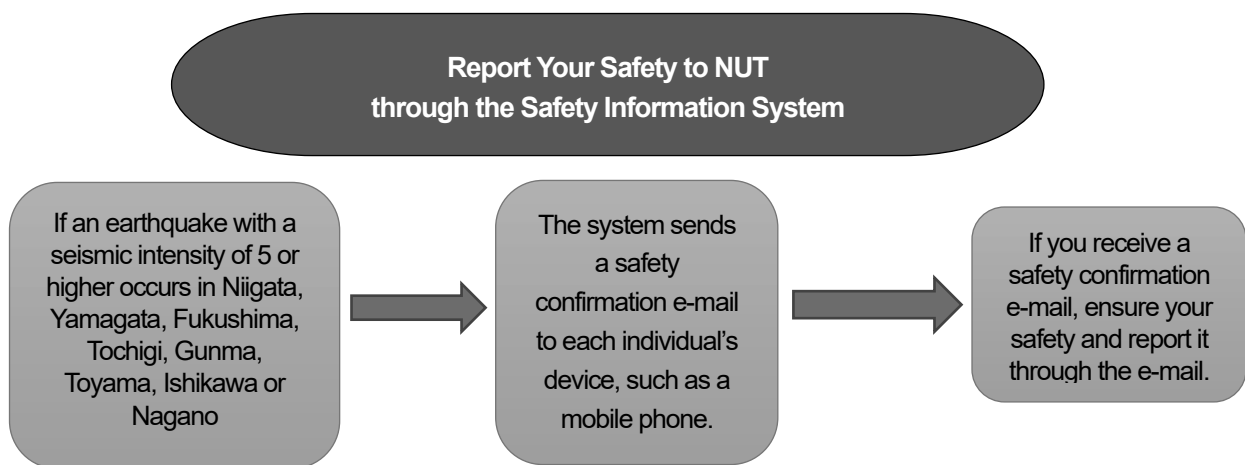
In emergency, call the following number: Toll-free for 24 hours

- Accident or Crime … Dial 110 for Police Station
- Fire or Medical Emergency … Dial 119 for Fire Station

1. Natural Disasters

Japan has many natural disasters like earthquakes, typhoons, and torrential rain. When a disaster occurs, calm down and ensure your security. Try not to act alone.

NUT uses ANPIC, Safety Information System, to confirm students' safety in an emergency. When a natural disaster such as an earthquake occurs, a safety confirmation e-mail is sent to the e-mail addresses you registered beforehand. Do not forget to register your email address in advance.

2. Traffic Accident

When you are involved in a traffic accident, follow the steps below. However, please keep in mind to follow the traffic rules and drive safely to prevent any accident in the first place. **You must purchase a voluntary insurance, *Nin-i-hoken***, when you own a car so that the insurance covers any damages in a case of an accident. If you have an accident, you may not only be penalized and imprisoned but also compensate for damage. Fee for the hospital and pain-and-suffering for the victim must be paid by the offender.

- 1. Give a first-aid treatment and call an ambulance**

If the victim is hurt or injured, call **an ambulance (Dial 119)** immediately and provide a first-aid treatment.

- 2. Call the police**

All accidents must be reported to **the police (Dial 110)** regardless of the scale of damage. DO NOT settle the accident by yourself. The police need to conduct an on-site investigation to issue an “Accident Certificate”, which you need to make a claim to insurance company, etc.

- 3. Exchange contact information**

Ask for the other driver’s name, address, contact number, and insurance company information, etc.

- 4. Find witnesses and gather information**

If there are any witnesses such as pedestrians, drivers and passengers in other vehicles, ask their testimony, and acquire their contact information if possible. Take photos of the accident site to keep the record.

- 5. Contact your insurance company and see a doctor**

- 6. Report to NUT**

3. Loss or Theft of Money and Valuables

If your money or valuable are lost or stolen on campus, you must notify the Student Affairs office (0258-47-9253) or the police off campus (0258-38-0110). For loss of credit cards or bankcards, notify the corresponding agencies as well.

In case of emergency, call the following number and report to NUT as well.

- Emergency occurred on campus (Facility breakage/trouble, etc.)
