To non-regular students whose period of stay in Japan is less than 3 months

## Be sure to purchase travel insurance before you travel to Japan!

If your stay in Japan is less than 3 months, you are not eligible for National Health Insurance. This means that you will be responsible for the full amount (100%) of your medical expenses.

Medical costs in Japan are high. Please find and purchase your own insurance <u>to</u> cover medical expenses for injuries and illnesses during your stay in Japan.

Once you have joined, please submit a copy of your insurance policy to the International Student Affairs to verify that the period of insurance covers the period of your stay in Japan.



If you do not pay your medical expenses, you may be sued in court. It will also greatly affect future immigration screening.

Be sure to purchase insurance so that you can pay your medical fees.



## 渡日前に、必ず海外旅行保険に加入してください!

日本での滞在期間が3か月未満の場合、国民健康保険に加入することができないため、医療費の全額(10割)が自己負担となります。

日本の医療費は高額です。そのため、<u>日本滞在中のケガ・病気の医療費をカバーする</u>保険を探し、加入してください。

保険期間が留学期間をカバーしていることを確認するため、加入したら、保険証券の写しを留学生支援係に提出してください。
